

CALENDAR FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER – 2010

Unless otherwise indicated, tastings are Free and take Place on Friday & Saturday 12-7. A special presentation is usually scheduled on Saturday's 3p-6p. Often when there is a food pairing of some sort, the pairing is available only during the presentation on Saturday, and I will usually mention that in my weekly newsletter.

8 & 9 WINES OF HUNGARY. A local importer, Edward Mandity, who specializes in Hungarian wines has worked closely with me for this very edited presentation of his wines. On Saturday 3p-6p only there will also be a food pairing with gourmet Hungarian treats. I am as excited about this little surprise as you will be. The tasting includes a "Tokaji Aszu", which is over my usual \$25 price limit, and for those of you have never had an authentic Tokaji, this will be especially interesting.

15 & 16 VINA ROBLES of PASO ROBLES. This California winemaker has been rewarded with lots of accolades, and I will be including their 2007 Petite Sirah, which garnered 93 pts from Wine Enthusiast, and which will be priced with a special discount for the tasting.

22 & 23 ROCK POINT WINES, OREGON. Tim Brennon of A & B Imports has assembled a presentation of this Southern Oregon grown, produced, and bottled winery. A family business dedicated to the creation of quality wine at an affordable price.

29 & 30 HALLOWEEN & WINTER PARTY WINES. You don't want anything TOO scary, TOO cutesy, TOO weird, or TOO Halloweeny...but if you are meeting up with friends at someone's house, or having people over for Halloween or anytime during the Winter "Red Wines Season", you are probably looking for something that tastes great, but is in a larger format to put the price in the \$8-12 per 750ml equivalent price point. The tasting will include wines in the liter, 1.5 liter, and even the very popular Silver Palm, 3-Liter (equivalent of 4 bottles @ \$10 per bottle).
