HAHN Family Estates: Monterey County, CA

The Hahn Family Vineyards are located in the Santa Lucia Highlands of Monterey County, home to a number of California's highly regarded and innovative appellations. The mission of the winery is to produce wines that are stylistically complex, supple and enjoyable upon release. The spirited Rooster ("Hahn" in German) has been in the family home for over 250 years, and symbolizes the persistence and dedication to their endeavors.

1. Hahn Estates Chardonnay 2008 - \$11.96

Our most complete Chardonnay to date. A blend of barrel fermented and tank fermented juice create a lush palate of tropical fruits and green apple that finishes with crisp acidity. Try this wine with seafood.

2. Hahn Estates Pinot Noir Monterey 2007 - \$11.96

A dynamic and multi-faceted wine with deep ruby hues, aromas of clove and pepper, and a tangy burst of fruit and spice on the palate. A DOUBLE-GOLD award winner at the San Francisco International Wine Competition, and selected BEST PINOT NOIR and BEST OF CLASS at Jerry Mead's New World International Wine Competition.

3. Hahn Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Central Coast 2008 - \$11.96

A deep, plum-hued wine that opens with aromas of vanilla spice, followed by cocoa and cinnamon. Dark red fruit notes with intense blackberry flavors entice the senses.

4. Hahn Estates Central Coast Meritage 2008 - \$14.96

Deep, bold, brooding and complex, this wine has a heightened level of intensity compared to previous vintages. A generous percentage of Petit Verdot and Malbec in the blend add depth and enhance the richness of the wine. Juicy, luscious flavors combined with brisk tannins to make this wine the perfect complement for strong, savory meats and hearty pasta dishes.

5. Hahn Estate Cabernet Franc 2006 - \$14.96

Rich and medium dark ruby in color, it is smooth with a subtle, spicy taste of clove and white pepper woven between supple, rich flavors of cocoa, soil and leather. Pleasant, light and low in tannins, this wine is smooth, focused and leaves a melody of taste in the mouth. This Cabernet Franc finishes strongly with pleasing tart flavors of cran-raspberry and smooth layers of black currant and plum. Enjoy it with a pork chop stuffed with apples and cranberries.
